## **Browser Requirements**

## Version and cipher strength

Ensure your Internet Explorer version is version 6.0 or above and your cipher strength 128-bit or above. To verify it, from your browser toolbar click on Help and then select **About Internet Explorer.**

#### **Disable pop up blockers**

Ensure you have disabled all pop-up blockers which may prevent Oracle web pages from launching. Go to your **Pop-up Blocker** settings to disable the tool <u>WHILE YOU ARE USING ORACLE APPLICATIONS</u>.

To verify, from the Internet Explorer menu bar click on Tools > Pop-up Blocker > Turn Off Pop Up Blocker.
