VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

The Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations is executing a Technical Assistance (TA) Project (UTF/NEP/073/NEP) to support the implementation of Agriculture and Food Security Project (AFSP) directly implemented by the Ministry of Agricultural Development of the Government of Nepal under grant assistance of Global Agriculture and Food Security Programme (GAFSP) and supervisory support of the World Bank. The project is operational in the 19 districts of hills and mountains of Mid and Far western regions of Nepal and is due to be completed by the end of 2017. The main objective of the AFSP is to enhance food and nutrition security of targeted beneficiaries primarily through increased productivity of both crop and livestock and promotion of improved dietary intake of diversified diets as well as improved feeding and caring practices of pregnant and nursing women and children up to 2 years of age.
