- carry out classification reviews and prepare reports ensuring adherence to policy and consistency of approach;
- analyze complex issues relating to classification and position management and provide recommendations and solutions;
- provide advice on workforce and succession planning to support dynamic evolution of structures and effective deployment of post resources.

- University degree in Human Resources Management, Public or Business Administration or a related field
- Five years of relevant experience in human resources management including experience in workforce planning, staffing, organizational design and job classification
- Working knowledge of English essential. Working knowledge of French or Spanish would be an asset.

- Experience in an international organization in particular in the UN Common System is considered a strong asset
