DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the overall supervision of the ERP Technical Manager the incumbent will contribute to the design, development and implementation of the FAO Enterprise Resource planning (ERP) software upgrade. In particular, will:

- Lead systems analysis design activities and provide expert advice on functional and technical design, application configuration on Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) software;
- Evaluate the design, quality, stability and maintainability of proposed modifications & enhancements required to fill gaps between standard ERP functionality and business requirements.
- Provide input to the development of the overall ERP design architecture and ensure that any proposed modifications & enhancements are consistent with the said design.
- Liaise, where appropriate, with the technical team and business units during integration testing, user acceptance testing and production deployment of system components to facilitate the successful roll-out of the upgraded system to production.
- Supervise junior staff and consultants assigned to ERP analysis, design and configuration activities.
- Develop relevant design documentation to be used for functional requirement validation and system development.
- Perform other related duties as required.

- Working knowledge of English

- Demonstrated analytical skills and ability in resolving problems quickly and tactfully, exercising sound judgement and decision making
