- Participate in the integration of applications with WSO2 infrastructure;
- Ensure Intranet and Internet web site development for DOs as per their needs liaising with senior staff across the decentralized office network;
- Coordinate the development of on-demand mobile applications;
- Provide expert advice to Senior – Users and End-Users in order to assure the best user experience related to the applications;
