DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Integrated Food Security Phase Classification (IPC) is a multi-agency initiative promoting a standardized approach to classification of food security. Under the overall supervision of the Director, ESA, the technical guidance of the EU/FAO Programme Coordinator and in collaboration with the Senior Economist (IPC Programme Manager) the incumbent will serve as Senior Economist (IPC Technical Manager) for the IPC Global Support Unit and will:

- coordinate the institutional and technical development of the IPC with the support of the Technical Advisory Group and in close collaboration with the Regional and Country Advisers;
- manage work plans and activities of technical officers and consultants;
- coordinate with IPC project staff in regions and countries on implementation of IPC activities and provide technical advice on demand basis;
- manage the future revision process to incorporate feedback from implementation of the IPC Manual Version 2, and build lessons learnt;
- coordinate the Technical Advisory Group involved in ongoing development of the IPC and conduct applied research on IPC related topics;
- contribute to capacity development by ensuring the development of the training materials on the IPC Manual Version 2 as well as implementing training programmes on Version 2;
- provide technical advice to countries and regions for external peer reviews upon request;
- ensure minimum quality standards of IPC analysis are fulfilled according the Quality Assistance guidelines;
- perform other related duties as required.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS
