#### DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the general supervision of the Coordinator, Products, Trade and Marketing Service and the immediate supervision of the Senior Fishery Industry Officer, the incumbent will provide technical advice and support and participate in relevant activities to the technological aspects of fish and fishery products and in the utilization of aquatic living resources from capture fisheries and aquaculture. In particular, the incumbent will:

- provide Advice to Member Governments for the efficient implementation of the Code of Conduct for Responsible Fisheries, particularly in the area of post harvest activities, on all aspects of fish utilization, safety and quality;
- identify and analyse new trends and developments in fish utilization, safety and quality and provide relevant technical advice to Member Countries;
- analyze fish utilization, safety and quality issues of importance to donors, link to donor priorities and assist in the preparation of project proposals;
- provide the necessary technical support and guidance to departmental initiatives and activities, in particular those related to aquaculture and fisheries product utilization, safety and quality;
- develop training materials and participate in the conduct of national, regional or global training courses, and participate in international meetings and seminars concerned with fish utilization, safety and quality;
- liaise with partner institutions in both developing and developed countries in order to promote their involvement in FAO's programme of work in fish utilization, quality and safety;
- liaise with the Secretariat of the FAO/WHO Codex Alimentarius Commission on implementation of the programme of the Codex Committee on Fish and Fishery products and other relevant committees;
- perform other related duties as required.

#### MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

*Candidates should meet the following:*

- Advanced University Degree in disciplines relevant to fish utilization, safety and quality, such as Food Science, Food Technology, Food Engineering, Veterinary Medicine or related subjects
- Seven years of relevant experience in areas related to fish utilization, safety and quality
- Working knowledge of English, French or Spanish and limited knowledge of one of the other two or Russian, Chinese or Arabic

#### SELECTION CRITERIA

*Candidates will be assessed against the following:*

- Relevance of academic background and extent of experience in the field of fish utilization, safety and quality at national and international level
- Demonstrated experience in supporting and guiding multi-disciplinary and multi-cultural teams in the preparation of technical documents, workshops and meetings and in developing and implementing capacity building projects/programmes
- Extent and relevance of experience of working in developing countries
- Quality of both oral and written communication skills on technical issues
- Extent of language skills
