#### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

Under the overall managerial and administrative supervision of the Assistant Director-General/Regional Representative (ADG/RR) for Asia and the Pacific, the functional guidance of the Research and Extension Group, NRDR, and in close coordination with the Group Coordinators of the Agriculture and Food Systems Group (RAPTA) and the Natural Resources and Environment Group (RAPTN), the incumbent will be responsible for the promotion of agricultural research, extension, and education for development and rural youth programmes and activities in the Region. The incumbent will also contribute to strengthening partnership and knowledge networks within and outside the Organization, supporting country-level actions guided by FAO's Country Programme Framework (CPF) as well as increasing South-South and triangular cooperation. In particular, the incumbent will:

- support country-level actions guided by FAO's Country Programming Frameworks (CPFs), subregional and regional priority
  frameworks and higher-level strategic frameworks of the Organization in order to transform FAO's knowledge products into
  country-level results and impacts;
- participate in agricultural sector reviews and assess the need for strengthening agricultural innovation systems, research, extension, and education for development and rural youth programmes at the country, subregional and regional levels; contribute to the promotion of agricultural research, extension and education programmes, projects and other activities at the country, subregional and regional level;
- provide technical advice to governments, institutions, NGOs, academia and other relevant stakeholders on issues related to agricultural research, extension and education policy and programmes within the context of sustainable rural and agricultural development;
- promote and implement participatory, gender-sensitive, client-oriented and pluralistic extension approaches and cost-effective methodologies, research-extension-farmers linkages, training and extension programmes;
- contribute to the promotion of regional partnerships and networking and regional participation in global partnerships for the development of capacities in the field of agricultural innovation;
- provide advice and technical assistance to improve the relevance of curriculum, quality of the teaching and learning processes and the overall approach to the management of educational institutions focusing on agriculture and related subjects;
- provide technical advice and backstopping on the design and implementation of FAO projects and programme activities at the country, subregional and regional levels in the areas of agricultural research, extension, education and rural youth;
- support the preparation and organization of meetings, seminars, and workshops at the country, sub-regional and regional level;
- collaborate with NRDR and other FAO divisions through inter-disciplinary activities and liaise with APPARI, CGIR institutions, academic institutions and other UN agencies and regional and international organizations and relevant networks in the Region in the implementation of programmes in the above areas;
- · perform other related duties as required.

## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Candidates should meet the following:

- Advanced University Degree in an area related to agriculture, research, extension, education or related field
- · Seven years of relevant experience in agricultural research, or extension and education programmes
- · Working knowledge of English and a limited knowledge of Arabic, Chinese, French, Russian or Spanish

- Extent of, and relevance of experience in agricultural research, extension and education concepts, policies and issues

- Demonstrated capacity to work in teams and maintain effective working relationships with institutions, networks and agencies
