DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the general supervision of the Director, Nutrition Division, and as a member of one or more task teams, the incumbent will contribute to FAO's work on nutrition policy and governance. In particular, the incumbent will:

- provide evidence-based analysis and technical advice on nutrition enhancing policies, strategies and programmes;
- assist in supporting sub regional and regional priority and higher-level strategic frameworks of the Organization in order to transform FAO's nutrition knowledge products into country-level results and impacts;
- contribute to FAO's capacity development programmes on food security and nutrition, and support implementation of relevant policies and guidelines;
- contribute to field programme development by participating in the identification, formulation, implementation, backstopping and review of projects ensuring that nutrition is mainstreamed across disciplines;
- provide input into the development of information products including technical and policy reports, guidelines and manuals for nutrition;
- plan, organize and participate in technical meetings and workshops for assisting the transfer of knowledge and information on nutrition in agriculture;
- contribute to, and participate in FAO's interdisciplinary programmes and task forces (e.g. gender, livelihoods, urban nutrition, post-2015 development), and assist with nutrition-related liaison activities with international and regional institutions, NGO networks and donor organisations;
- perform other related duties as required.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Candidates should meet the following:

- Advanced university degree in Nutrition, Food Science or related discipline
- Five years of progressively responsible professional experience in nutrition policy and programmes, including developing country experience
- Working knowledge of English, and limited knowledge of Arabic, Chinese, French, Russian or Spanish

- Extent and relevance of work experience, including developing country experience
- Level of knowledge of nutrition policy and programme initiatives

- Quality of both oral and written communication skills
