DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the overall supervision of the Second International Conference on Nutrition (ICN2) coordinator and the direct supervision of the ICN2 Programme Officer, the incumbent will assist in providing technical support for the preparations for the ICN2. In particular, the incumbent will:

- conduct a desk review of technical background documents and papers related to the thematic areas of the ICN2 and especially to (1) social protection and nutrition; (2) nutrition-enhancing agriculture and food systems; and (3) measurement of malnutrition;
- contribute to discussions for preparing for and following up the ICN2 meetings and events, including the main event in November 2014;
- undertake background research and provide technical inputs for the preparation of technical papers and reports including nutrition country papers and case studies for the ICN2;
- facilitate mainstreaming of nutrition into FAO's Strategic Objectives;
- perform other related duties as required.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Candidates should meet the following:

- Advanced university degree in human nutrition, or in international development, agriculture and food policy with focus on nutrition or related fields
- One year of relevant experience in nutrition, in particular in food and nutrition security policies, strategies and programmes
- Working knowledge of English, French or Spanish and limited knowledge of one of the other two or Arabic, Chinese or Russian

SELECTION CRITERIA

Candidates will be assessed against the following:

- Relevance of experience in food and nutrition security policies and programmes with experience in developing countries
- Ability to plan and organize own work, deliver results and meet deadlines
