## **CALL FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST**

### **Network Engineer**

### **Tasks and responsibilities:**

Under the overall supervision of the IT Architect, CIO and in close collaboration with the IT Officer for Decentralized Offices and Global IT Infrastructure, CIO, the incumbent will ensure the successful redesign of the network in FAO's Headquarters in Rome. The incumbent will be responsible for all network activities related to the implementation of the new network devices and of the reconfiguration/consolidation of existing devices as follows:

- Document current data centre network diagrams physical/logical and data centre traffic volumes
- Install and configure the new data centre firewalls
- Install and configure the new Internet router for high availability with existing infrastructure
- Review and configure the F5 firewalls in line with new proposed network architecture
- Consolidate corporate firewalls and deploy/configure network devices to increase redundancy and high availability of LAN and internet access;
- Raise LAN switching/routing to ISO layer 3 by extending VLAN routing and introducing VRF-security zoning;
- Clean-up cabling in the data centre freeing up unused ports and network devices;
- Clean-up and implement access layer redundancy within the 32 floor wiring concentrators across FAO HQ;
- Upgrade the wireless controller and update the HQ wireless network infrastructure;
- Review and implement monitoring tool configuration changes to ensure coverage of entire infrastructure;
- Update technical documentation and operational procedures related to the network infrastructure and train technical support staff for day to day operational management.

All work will be performed in line with existing FAO IT policies and procedures, following ITIL best practices and all documentation/status reports will be prepared in English.

- Fully acquainted with and capable of facing multitasking environment, meeting tight deadlines and handling matters related to IT and procurement in a professional manner
- Candidate must have the ability to work harmoniously with people of different national and cultural backgrounds.
