Tasks and responsibilities:

In coordination with the FENIX team, the consultant will contribute to the development of client-side components of the WIEWS and africaFertilizer.org (AFO) applications using the core components of the FENIX IT platform.

Under the overall guidance of the CIO Director and the Senior IT Officer, and under the direct supervision of the FENIX Coordinator, the consultant will perform the following tasks:

1. Analyze the user's requirements of the applications and liaise with the AFO and WIEWS managers to ensure that the development work reflects the user's expectations.
2. Improve the current client side architectures to increase its flexibility, performance and user-friendliness and to restructure existing functionalities using the latest FENIX technology.
3. Implement tools and applications to allow users to query and visualize data using dashboards, as required. Data should be selectively retrieved using the FENIX protocols in accordance with the required business logic.
4. Integrate the new applications with the FAO corporate Content Management System (Typo3) and use the widget approach to embed the required FENIX functionalities in the fronted components.
5. Test the developed functionalities and carry out bug-fixing.
6. Other tasks as required.
