Tasks and responsibilities

FAO is looking for a Taleo cloud solutions functional specialist to assist with the implementation of Taleo recruitment and onboarding at FAO.

Under the direct supervision of the Project Manager, the consultant will perform the following tasks:

- Manage Oracle Taleo Recruitment and Onboarding configuration and administration
- Document business requirements and design business processes
- Conduct functional and technical workshops to present best practice within Taleo functionality
- Conduct user acceptance training, including creation/presentation of scripts to clients
- Primarily responsible for the configuration, administration, and maintenance of the Talent Acquisition System based on requirements identified during the Architect phase
- Partner closely with the IT division and Third Party Vendors on issues related to integration with other existing legacy systems
- Partner with My Oracle Support for technical issues/bugs/resolutions beyond access capability
