#### **Tasks and responsibilities:**

FAO's Office of Evaluation (OED), in partnership with national partners the TEGEMEO Institute of Agricultural Policy and Development and the Kenyan Institute for Public Policy Research and Analysis (KIPPRA), is launching an evaluation of FAO's Programme in Kenya from 2013-2016. The evaluation will cover the totality of FAO's programme in Kenya throughout the 2013-2016 period, broadly centred on policy development, agricultural production, land and natural resource management, resilience and support to knowledge development and management.

The purpose of the Kenya CPE is to provide inputs to better orient FAO's programme, making it more relevant to the needs of the country. The CPE is a means for FAO to be accountable to the Government and non-government partners and resource partners in the country, as well as all member countries. It seeks to contribute to learning at corporate, regional and country levels by drawing lessons and making recommendations that will be useful for FAO's future engagement in the country.
