The FAO Information Technology Division (CIO) is seeking Expressions of Interest (EOIs) from qualified data engineers.

Suitable candidates will have designed and implemented applications based the Microsoft SharePoint 2013 platform.

Tasks and responsibilities:

Under the overall direction of the Senior Software Development Officer, and the day to day management of the software development technical team leader, they will perform the following duties with respect to information systems:

- Participate in an Agile software development team implementing SharePoint applications that deliver real business in the shortest time.
- Develop applications in SharePoint.
- Participate in design discussions, develop mock-ups and translate business requirements into technical tasks.
- Program, test, debug and maintain applications based on the SharePoint platform; also address systems performance issues and crashes as per operations requests when necessary.
- Participate in defining, implementing and mainstreaming SharePoint best practices and procedures.
- Ensure compliance with appropriate organizational standards in close collaboration with quality assurance (QA) and information and system architecture.
- Other related duties as necessary.
