GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF TASK(S) AND OBJECTIVES TO BE ACHIEVED:

Under the direct supervision of the Rural Youth Migration Officer based at FAOSNE and the technical supervision of the Senior Programme Advisor, under the overall supervision of the sub-Regional Coordinator of FAOSNE and in close collaboration with team members of the project GCP/INT/240/ITA based at FAO HQ and at country and regional offices, the international consultant will conduct the following tasks:

1. Based on the capacity needs assessments on migration and rural development carried out for Tunisia and Ethiopia, develop a mapping of capacity needs of policy makers and development practitioners to better address the nexus between migration and rural development at individual, organisational and policy levels
2. Develop a roadmap for capacity development on migration and rural development in Tunisia and Ethiopia and relative planning of capacity development materials and workshops formats to fill the identified capacity gaps (point 1), complementing ongoing project activities and other actions implemented by partners at country level
3. Develop tailored capacity development materials on migration and rural development, especially for strengthening the attention to rural development in migration policy and of migration in agricultural and rural development policies, for different target audiences at the policy and technical level of national and international institutions; adapted to the country contexts and needs, to be piloted in Tunisia and Ethiopia
4. Organise and facilitate at least three capacity development workshops (two in Tunisia and one in Ethiopia) to strengthen stakeholders' capacity to address in a coherent way issues of migration, employment and rural development at programme and policy levels, with clear linkages with emerging good practices and relevant national strategies and policies
5. Review the piloted training materials (output 3) by integrating feedback from the training (including participant's assessments and relevant additional material by FAO and partner organisations) and develop a training manual of publishable quality including conceptual issues, presentations and learning exercises, that can be used in other country contexts.
6. Contribute to other relevant capacity development activities on migration and rural development and perform other related tasks as required.

Development of capacity development materials tailored to specific contexts and training needs of stakeholders in Tunisia and Ethiopia (in English and French)4. Organisation and co-facilitation of at least three capacity development events (two in Tunisia and one in Ethiopia), which will also serve to pilot the training materials5. Revision of training materials based on the pilot trainings, including participants and partners' feedback and development of a training manual of publishable quality, with versions in English and French6.
