#### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF TASK(S) AND OBJECTIVES TO BE ACHIEVED:**

Under the overall supervision of Peter Wobst (ESP), Senior Programme Advisor, and Decent Rural Employment Team (DRET) Leader, and Elisenda Estruch (ESP), Labour Economist, and relevant DRET team members, the consultant will contribute to the implementation of FAO capacity development activities on migration, agricultural and rural development, including in support of FAO Decentralized Offices and respective ESP-led migration projects (Tunisia, Ethiopia, Senegal and Kenya). Specifically, the incumbent will:

- Support the overall implementation and coordination of capacity development (CD) activities on migration, agricultural and rural development, including global components as well regional and country-level activities, ensuring the coherence and cross-fertilisation of CD materials developed under different initiatives. Liaise with the professional staff in HQ, regional and national level, as needed;
- Develop relevant CD and guidance materials on migration, agriculture and rural development in collaboration with implementing partners and relevant FAO technical staff;
- Conduct CD activities at country level to field test the CD materials and increase capacity of key stakeholders, in Senegal and Kenya, and provide support to CD activities in Tunisia and Ethiopia and in other FAO country and regional offices as relevant;
- Organize webinars and other on-line CD sessions in the framework of ESP-led migration projects and other FAO corporate processes including at regional level;
- Contribute to FAO's global work on migration, including to FAO's engagement in the Global Migration Group, as needed;
- Support resource mobilization efforts on rural migration, including formulation of concept notes and project proposals and in line with FAO's migration work programme and priorities;
- Perform other related duties as required
