Organizational Setting

The post is based in the FAO Representation in Egypt located in Cairo.

Reporting Lines

The National Value Chain Consultant reports to the FAO Representative in Egypt under the day-to-day supervision of the Nutrition and Food Systems Officer.

Technical Focus

Food loss and waste reduction, value chain development, marketing and agro-food enterprise development.

Tasks and responsibilities

The National Value Chain Consultant will support implementation of activities for the Egypt component of "GCP/RNE/004/ITA: Food Loss and Waste reduction and Value Chain Development for Food Security in Egypt and Tunisia". The Value Chain Consultant will work in close collaboration with the project Lead Technical Officer (LTO), National Project Focal Point and Government officials, project partners and stakeholders, to perform the following duties:

General Responsibilities

- Liaise and collaborate actively with the project team, FAO Representation, government focal points to the project, project staff and other project stakeholders, on a regular basis;
- Implement project activities as required and prescribed by the project WPB;
- Liaise, coordinate and organize with external participants (technical support missions, national and international consultants, etc.);
- Contribute with data and information to the project's monitoring and evaluation system, and progress reports;
- Liaise with concerned technical departments of the governments to exchange information and facilitate collaboration for project implementation.

Specific Technical Duties

- Contribute to the research on tomato and grape value chains in Egypt, along with appointed national and/ or international food value chain researchers and national institutions;
 - Contribute to the process of identifying, recruiting and/or training a cadre of national service providers in subject matters such as value chain development, enterprise development, farm business management, postharvest management, logistics, etc ;
 - Liaise, coordinate, organize and guide the cadre of national service providers for implementation of project activities ;
 - Contribute to the research or appraisal of existing and potential business models between smallholders suppliers and domestic and regional buyers of grape and tomato products;
 - Food chain actors in the chosen geographic zones, in particular small-scale farmers, traders and SMAEs, with an emphasis on women participation, are mentored and coached in business linkages and partnerships
 - Contribute to the identification of capacity building needs for policy makers, service providers and value chain actors; contribute to the development of training materials according to FAO standards; actively participate in project trainings
 - Design, compile and be responsible for the database on identified project beneficiaries;
 - Organize, facilitate and actively contribute to technology demonstrations provided by the project;
 - Contribute to the organization of events, workshops and conferences to present, discuss and endorse the project findings for value chain development and food losses and waste reduction with relevant national, regional and international stakeholders;
 - Actively contribute to project communication efforts;
 - Perform any other duties as required.
