Organizational Setting

CGIAR is an international research partnership focusing on agricultural scientific research for development.

The Independent Evaluation Arrangement (IEA) of the CGIAR is responsible for external evaluations of the complex research programmes and for developing a coordinated and harmonized evaluation framework within the CGIAR. The Head of IEA reports directly to the CGIAR System Council, liaising closely with the CGIAR System Office and CGIAR Centers.

IEA is looking for an Evaluation Analyst, based in the IEA office in Rome (located in FAO) to provide support in the management of evaluations, perform analytical tasks for evaluations and assist in the development of methodological tools.

Reporting Lines

The Consultant will report directly to the Head of the Independent Evaluation Arrangement (AGDE).

Tasks and responsibilities

Under the direct supervision of the Head, IEA, the Consultant will:

- contribute to the design, planning, budgeting and implementation of complex evaluations;
- compile information and background material for evaluations;
- assist in the design of the evaluation framework and of evaluation tools;
- liaise with program/unit being evaluated and provide logistical assistance;
- conduct preparatory work and analysis for evaluations;
- carry out specific research, synthesis and reviews;
- participate in evaluation missions;
- perform other related duties as required (management of consultant roster, evaluation database).

- From five to seven years of relevant experience in evaluation in the context of international development
