## Organizational Setting

The Information Technology Division (CIO) is responsible for all IT activities within the Organization. CIO performs on behalf of the Organization the following critical roles: defining FAO IT policies and providing strategic advice on IT architecture and standards, governance, policy and operational matters while monitoring organizational compliance; defining the mechanisms for managing FAO's information and data; protecting FAO's information assets and ensuring confidentiality, integrity and availability; ensuring provision of IT services that are core for the Organization's global operations and supporting the information and business processes; coordinating organization-wide IT activities in order to reduce duplication and fragmentation and to increase integration of information data, systems and platforms, mobilizing IT resources from across the Organization.

Under the direct supervision of the Information Technology Officer (Development area), the candidate will act as developer performing the following functions.

## Technical Focus

The Web Developer works for FAO's IT Division as part of an agile software development team, designing and building high quality web applications.

## Tasks and responsibilities

- Contribute to design and planning, developing mock-ups, business and data processes and translating business requirements into technical tasks.
  - Develop, test and debug TYPO3 Websites; address systems performance issues and crashes as per operations requests when necessary.
  - Participate in the development and implementation and other Web applications in support of FAO technical divisions and corporate Web publishing projects in close collaboration with OCC;
  - Participate in the customization of templates and extensions for the implementation of corporate and thematic Web sites, based on best practices for the design and development of the WCMS modules;
  - Participate in the configuration and customization of corporate pages, in particular to be compliant with mobile devices;
  - Participate in the integration of third parties' widgets into the corporate WCMS;
  - Ensure correct development of Web template as per corporate guidelines;
  - Provide expert advice to Senior Users and End-Users in order to assure the best user experience related to the supported WCMS;
  - Contribute to the code optimization and performances monitoring of the corporate CMS;
  - Participate in user training sessions;
  - Ensure that the help material is up to date and in line with the organizational needs;
  - Prepare technical documentation as needed;
  - Perform other related duties as required.
