Organizational Setting

The Information Technology Division (CIO) is responsible for all IT activities within the Organization. CIO performs on behalf of the Organization the following critical roles: defining FAO IT policies and providing strategic advice on IT architecture and standards, governance, policy and operational matters while monitoring organizational compliance; defining the mechanisms for managing FAO's information and data; protecting FAO's information assets and ensuring confidentiality, integrity and availability; ensuring provision of IT services that are core for the Organization's global operations and supporting the information and business processes; coordinating organization-wide IT activities in order to reduce duplication and fragmentation and to increase integration of information data, systems and platforms, mobilizing IT resources from across the Organization.

Reporting Lines

Under the direct supervision of the Information Technology Officer (IT Services), the consultant will act as Network Administrator performing the following functions.

Technical Focus

The Network Administrator will be responsible for the correct operation and management of the global telecommunications infrastructure of the organization.

Tasks and responsibilities

- Performing daily operational monitoring and housekeeping activities such as VLAN and firewall rule management, log reviews, firmware updates, network cabling reviews, device inventory, core infrastructure optimization, etc.
- Installing, configuring and managing network and communications devices and keep the configuration and technical documentation up-to-date to ensure the correct operation and support of the global network and communications infrastructure
- Ensuring capacity planning and project activities involving global network and communications infrastructure are fit for purpose by providing technical guidance as needed
- Proposing and implementing system enhancements, including software and hardware updates that will improve performance, reliability, and scalability of the network.
- Managing individual network projects within the scope of the Network Team and FAO's ICT initiatives.
- Ensuring all network monitoring & management tools remain up to date.
- Ensuring automatic backup of all network device configurations.
- Monitoring the technology and/or methodology trends and supporting the teams to apply these within the FAO's environment.
- · Performing second and third level support on the global network infrastructure for all users in HQ and in decentralized offices.
- · Raising and following cases with vendor TAC Support as required.
- Liaising with ISPs in order to resolve contract and performance issues on WAN Links.
- Promoting improvements to, and contributing to the security of, the network infrastructure by adopting best-practices, emerging technologies and high security standards
- Contributing to the technical growth of the team and draft technical/operational documentation to maintain the operational framework up-to-date
- Any other duties as required

All work will be undertaken in compliance with the appropriate organizational standards and procedures and all IS/ICT products will conform to IT divisional technical, security and quality standards.

- Excellent troubleshooting skills at the network layer as well as the application layer. Ability to perform packet capture and analysis is expected
- Advanced scripting skills in Python and/or Perl, knowledge of Ansible a plus.
- Experience in managing Radius
- Good understanding of firewalls and security concepts.
- Hands-on experience with network management and monitoring, diagnostic and network analytics
- Extent and relevance of experience in supporting information technologies and communications within large-scale LAN and WAN environments
- ITIL certification and at least 2 certifications from a recognized organization (i.e. Cisco CCNP/CCDP, JNCIP, F5 CTS-LTM)
