CSAI is responsible for providing the facilities maintenance, infrastructural work, renovation and design services to the FAO Headquarters building and to the FAO Decentralized Offices.

Reporting Lines

The Junior Interior Designer Architect will report to the Facilities Management Officer.

Technical Focus

The consultant will independently plan and develop FAO architectural renovation projects with innovative and sustainable design, fair quality, moderate cost and feasible time plans. The consultant will produce shop drawings and technical specifications in English and Italian ready for bid. The consultant will use the FAO drawing and documental standards for architectural and engineering documents in the Building Information Management systems.

Tasks and responsibilities

- Design interior design solutions for the FAO headquarters building applying UN security and sustainable standards;
- Develop concept designs for meeting rooms interior design for headquarters building and prepare construction plans;
- Draw structural, electrical, HVAC, plumbing and installation systems for headquarters building;
- Provide visual aid architectural and 3D Graphic presentations;
- Propose public spaces design layouts with focus on functionality, maintenance, ergonomics and sustainability.

Furthermore the consultant will:

- Carry out site construction supervision of specific renovation projects with modern project management tools;
- Liaise with Italian Authorities including the Italian Cultural Heritage Office and the Technical Team of the Ministry of Public Works;
- Update HQ architectural plans and technical installations in the Revit database model;
- Ensure adherence to the FAO drawing and documental standards for architectural and engineering documents.
