Summary of Duties and Functions

Reporting directly to the Director-General, the Inspector-General independently designs, organizes and directs a coordinated programme of internal oversight of the programmes and operations of the Organization, in particular its risk management, control and internal governance processes, through internal audit and investigation. This includes:

- monitoring and evaluating the adequacy and effectiveness of the Organization's system of internal control, financial management and use of assets;
- providing the Director-General and the functions and programmes audited with independent, objective assurance and consulting services designed to add value and improve the organizations' operations.
- maintaining the Organization's capacity to investigate allegations of irregularities in the programmes and operations of the Organization;
- managing the budgetary and human resources of the Office of the Inspector General;
- representing the Organization in oversight matters (audit and investigation).

General Requirements

- Advanced University Degree in Auditing, Accounting, Law, Business or Public Administration or Management. A first level University Degree may be considered for applicants with certification from an internationally recognized auditing and accountancy body such as the Institutes of Certified Public Accountants, Chartered Accountants or Internal Auditors or equivalent in other national systems;
- Extensive experience in a complex oversight function at the international level, of which at least 10 years at an executive level;
- High level and progressively responsible professional experience in a large organization with use of state-of-the-art auditing and management techniques based on advanced information technology;
- Demonstrated leadership and managerial skills of a high order;
- Familiarity with the UN system or similar international institutions;
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with people of different national and cultural background;
- Working knowledge of English, French or Spanish and a limited knowledge of any of the other two or Arabic, Chinese or Russian.
