GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF TASK(S) AND OBJECTIVES TO BE ACHIEVED

The FAO REU Regional Initiative on Agri-Food Trade and Market Integration is a program funded by a combination of FAO regular program and project funds. The total value of the Regional Initiative is currently about \$730,000. The primary goal of the Regional Initiative on Agri-food Trade and Market Integration is to support member countries in enhancing the agri-food trade policy environment for small and medium sized enterprises. The Initiative is built on the belief that enhancing the trade policy environment for modern agri-food markets requires the development of capacity both for trade agreements and for domestic food safety and quality standards. Thus, the Initiative will (a) build the capacity of government officials in the implementation of trade agreements, and (b) develop their capacity to create a supportive environment for trade. In addition, (c) the Initiative will develop the capacity of both governments and enterprises to implement international food quality and safety standards.

The Regional Office for Europe and Central Asia in Budapest, Hungary is currently seeking a program and reporting officer for the FAO REU Regional Initiative on Agri-Food Trade and Market Integration. The programme and reporting officer reports to the Regional Initiative Delivery Manager.

The responsibilities of the program assistant are:

- Monitor the budget of the regional initiative and report to the Delivery Manager
- Monitor program activities on a regular basis and report to the Delivery Manager
- Preparation of periodic reports on fulfillment of the program and attainment of milestones, according to the template provided by SP4
