DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the overall supervision of the FAO Representative in Nigeria (FAOR) and the technical supervision of the Chief, Integrated Food Security Support Service (TCSF), and in close collaboration with the National Project Coordinator of project UTF/NIR/048/NIR and the Federal Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (FMARD), will be responsible for the overall development of a Monitoring and Evaluation System for the Agriculture Transformation Agenda (ATA) and related food security, agriculture and rural development policies, programmes and projects. In particular, the incumbent will:

- prepare a detailed work plan for the development of a Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) System for the AATA
- review and analyze the adequacy of the resources, capabilities and performance of the existing M&E systems and their suitability for monitoring implementation and evaluating the impact of the ATA and related food security, agriculture and rural development policies, programmes and projects;
- review and analyse the adequacy and performance of the systems in place for exchanging information relevant to M&E between various departments of FMARD as well as the State Ministries of Agriculture (sub-national) and other government organizations involved with the ATA and related food security, agriculture and rural development policies, programmes and projects;
- organize a stakeholder consultation to present the findings and conclusions of the review of the existing M&E and information systems and to develop possible options for further developing and strengthening these systems based on the recommendations of the stakeholder consultation, support FMARD in the design, development and implementation of an improved M&E system that meets the M&E requirements of the ATA
- develop the required human resources and organizational capacities in FMARD and the other organizations involved with the ATA and related food security, agriculture and rural development policies, programmes and projects;
- ensure that an M&E system is put in place and implemented to monitor and evaluate the implementation of UTF/NIR/048/NIR and NPFS;
- perform other related duties, as required.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Candidates should meet the following:

- Advanced degree in economics or agricultural economics or social sciences or related field
- Seven years of relevant experience in the design and management of M&E systems preferably for food security, agriculture and rural development related programmes, including experience in both quantitative and qualitative methods;
- Working knowledge of English

SELECTION CRITERIA

Candidates will be assessed against the following:

- Solid experience with quantitative and qualitative M&E methods, tools and systems and with results-based management (RBM);
- Excellent comprehension of food security, agriculture and rural development in the context of developing countries;
- Experience with capacity development work in developing countries, in particular related to M&E and RBM;
- Courtesy, tact and ability to establish and maintain effective working relationship with other people of different nationalities and cultural backgrounds;
- Excellent communication skills.
- Ability to plan and coordinate the work priorities
