#### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF TASK(S) AND OBJECTIVES TO BE ACHIEVED**

The Meeting the Undernutrition Challenge (MUCH) project assists the Government of Bangladesh to achieve a strengthened enabling environment for eradicating food insecurity and malnutrition in Bangladesh, developing human and institutional capacities for designing and implementing food security policies and monitoring their implementation, with a specific focus on the National Food Policy Plan of Action (NFP PoA) and the Country Investment Plan (CIP). MUCH is housed within the premises of the Food Planning and Monitoring Unit (FPMU) of the Ministry of Food.

Under the overall supervision of the FAO Representative in Bangladesh, the direct supervision of the MUCH Chief Technical Advisor, the technical supervision of the Senior Policy Officer, RAP-ESP, and in close collaboration with relevant experts of the MUCH Technical Assistance Team and government officials, the international consultant will:

- 1. Facilitate inter-ministerial collaboration in monitoring the PoA and CIP, in particular by supporting the thematic team meetings (TT);
- 2. Contribute to the planning and elaboration of the PoA-CIP Monitoring Report 2016 (MR 2016) and other monitoring bulletins, including demand led and tailored on-the-job training on food and nutrition security (data collection and verification, writing and support to editing and finalization);
- 3. Carry-out analytical and policy advisory work related to Food and Nutrition Security;
- 4. Contribute to planning and delivering of training for FPMU and TT team members, and other MUCH partners;
- 5. Contribute to the food and nutrition security debate and inform the interventions of development partners by participating and actively contributing to meetings workshops and other events as requested;
- 6. Contribute to collate and organize relevant data in the FPMU Data Management System (DMS);
- 7. Perform related duties as deemed necessary by the Chief Technical Advisor.
