## GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF TASK(S) AND OBJECTIVES TO BE ACHIEVED

The Consultant will perform his duties under the overall supervision of the Director of the Social Protection Division (ESP), the direct supervision of the Decent Rural Employment Team Leader, and the technical supervision of the assigned officers from the Decent Rural Employment Team (DRET). The Decent Rural Employment Team in ESP is central to the implementation of FAO's corporate work plan under Strategic Objective 3, Organizational Outcome 2 (SO3/OO2), "The rural poor have greater opportunities to access decent farm and non-farm employment". In this role, the team and its members interact with almost every TU at FAO HQ, as well as staff in FAO's ROs, SROs, and numerous COs. This applies particularly to the Consultant's work. In particular, the Consultant will perform the following tasks:

- Contribute to the development and dissemination of knowledge materials led by DRET, including background research, policy briefs and technical or information notes;
- Provide technical support in DRET's contribution to knowledge materials led by other divisions under SO3/OO2.3 (REIN);
- Contribute to the development and strengthening of collaborations with other institutions for knowledge generation and dissemination on decent rural employment issues, including TUM, IFPRI, IFAD and ILO;
- Support resource mobilization efforts for knowledge generation and dissemination under SO3/OO2.3 (REIN), including drafting of concept notes and project proposals;
- Perform any other research/analytical activity that may be required.
