GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF TASK(S) AND OBJECTIVES TO BE ACHIEVED

Under the overall guidance of the Director NRL, and the direct supervision of the Deputy Directors NRL and NRC as leaders of the Technical Network Land & Tenure, and in close consultation with the Officers in NRL and NRC (including outposted Officers), the Consultant will perform the following duties:

- 1. Assessment of existing channels of communication and interaction on land and tenure issues related to agriculture and food security within and outside of FAO (with attention to operational networks and partnerships);
- 2. Overview of developments and trends related to land and tenure issues (current and forward looking taking into account work of key partners);
- 3. Mapping of actual expertise and ongoing and planned work and initial identification of critical, major gaps of knowledge and/or expertise in the technical and disciplinary capacities taking into account any controversial/ conflicting issues;
- 4. Scoping to set the topics and issues to be covered, taking into consideration the existing planning under the Strategic Objectives, Major Areas of Work and Regional Initiatives and required technical and disciplinary work priorities and focus to maintain pertinence and comparative advantage in response to needs and demands from country, regional and international levels;
- 5. Development of a strategic workplan and expected outcomes for the Technical Network for the biennium including activities and deliverables on the basis of a facilitated process with and inputs from network members on agreed priorities (issues and gaps) to be addressed, relevant technical or disciplinary networks in place, modalities for communication and information exchange, proposed extended members of the Technical Network.
