

ROSTER OF EXPERTS FOR JECFA DISCUSSIONS ON MYCOTOXINS

The 56th meeting of JECFA, to be held from 6-15 February 2001, is to be devoted to the evaluation of four groups of mycotoxins: Fumonisin, Ochratoxin A, Tricothecenes (DON and T-2 and HT-2 toxins) and Aflatoxins M₁.

Because of the comprehensive nature of the food safety assessments requested at this meeting, FAO decided to put on its Website a call for individuals to be included on a roster of candidates who could be called on to deal with mycotoxins at the 56th JECFA and/or any future meeting when mycotoxins are due to be considered.

The roster that has been set up as a result of this call is as set out below. Members for the 56th Session have now been selected from the names on the roster. It is intended to update the roster every two years.
