

What is the FAO GM Foods Platform?

- Simple online platform
- Share information on safety assessment of foods derived from recombinant-DNA plants
- In accordance with the Codex Plant Guidelines (CAC/GL 45-2003, annex III adopted in 2008)
- Managed by the food safety and quality unit of FAO
- Owned by FAO Members

How it works




- Freely accessible for visitors
- Only Focal Points can upload data/information
- Focal Points are officially nominated by the FAO Member governments


Current status of the Platform

- As of 28 February 2014
- 131 countries have nominated the Focal Points (aim is to have all 193 FAO Members)
- 119 countries have registered to the Platform
- 59 countries have completed their country profile page
- Platform hosts 297 records
