### Additional Data on Human Resources Management

### Information Note no. 1 - December 2017

1. The tables below present the data of annual progress in Human Resources Management, and complement the comprehensive analysis presented in the document FC 169/9, *Human Resources Management*.

2. *Table 1* shows the regional grouping of consultants (COF.REG.) by nationality indicating the location (headquarters or decentralized offices) and the duration of employment with FAO. As of 28 November 2017, 2,063 consultants were under contract with FAO, equally distributed between headquarters and decentralized offices.

3. *Table 2* lists the top 20 nationalities of consultants (COF.REG.) hired by the Organization as of November 2017.

4. *Table 3* presents the numbers of applications to Professional Vacancy Announcements (VAs) received in 2016 and 2017 per grade of the position. This is part of the outreach efforts of the Organization to increase and diversify the pool of applicants to professional positions. Although there is a slight decrease of applications for the VAs at P-3 level, the trend is positive for all other grades, in particular for positions at P-1 and P-2 levels, and in overall terms.

5. The overall Professional Vacancy Rate as of November 2017 is 15.2 percent as shown in *Table 4*.

6. *Table 5* shows the number of Member Nations by representation status. Over the past year, the number of non-represented countries has considerably decreased. Consequently, the number of under- and equitably-represented countries has increased.

7. *Table 6* presents FAO's total workforce by contract type as at November 2017. It includes all employees divided by categories of staff and non-staff human resources.
