(A) The Out-Grower Manager commits to carry out the following tasks during the tenure of contract:

- Identification and mobilization of potential chillie Out-Growers (farmers)
- Supplying viable seeds and facilitating appropriate trainings relevant to the crop.
- Visiting each Out-Growing farmer's field at least three (3) times during the growing period to ensure timely extension advice and communication to Out-Growing Company.
- Ensuring that a market for chillie is secured before growing the crop.
- Carrying out crop husbandry demonstrations to farmers - e.g. nursery management, transplanting, harvesting, grading, drying, etc.

(B) The Out-Growing farmers listed above commit to do the following during the tenure of the contract:

- Carrying out all standard crop husbandry practices required for chillie production such as nursery management, transplanting, harvesting, grading, drying, etc.
- Bearing all production, extension and marketing expenses for chillie.
- Attending all Out-Grower meetings/trainings when required at own expense.
- Ensuring that crop quality is maintained high as poor quality crop will not be accepted at the market but the loan will be paid in full.
- Delivering all the produced chillie to Out-Grower Manager meeting grading, drying and packaging requirements.
