Contract for the supply of Dairy Animals

The _____ (buyer) agrees to purchase dairy animals from you as long as the following conditions are met:

The in-calf dairy animals to be procured should be either pure Friesian or Jersey or cross breeds of dairy breeds.

- They should either be in-calf heifers or pregnant cows. The pregnancies should not be more than 7 months. This is to avoid abortions whilst in transit or shortly on arrival at the cooperatives' "Quarantine" stations.
- Pregnant cows should not have had more than three lactations. During the cows previous lactation the said dam should have had daily milk production of at least 15 litres.
- Dams of the in-calf heifers should have had daily milk production of not less than 15 litres during their previous lactation
- The dairy animals to be purchased should have no morphological defects such as blind teats, bad hooves, keratocojucvitis, pendulant udders, abscesses etc
- All the animals **MUST** have records (milk cards) illustrating their individual **identity** (i.e. ear tag/notch), sire, dam, year of birth, milk production (cows and dams), health status and any other relevant data that would be useful to the receiving SLIC farmers and cooperatives
- The farmer/seller should submit all the dairy management and health records of each dairy animal to the SLIC technical committee (ASP, ZATAC and LDT) prior to the purchase of the relevant dairy animals. The above information should be verified by the SLIC technical committee prior to the purchase of the animals.
