Tomato Cultivation and Purchase Contract

This contract was made by and between:

- (The Company) . registered to no. __, located in __, Iran represented by _ hereinafter called 'the company' on one hand, and,

- Ms _____, hereinafter called 'the seller' on the other hand, with the following terms and conditions:

Article 1: Subject of the Contract

Purchase of tomato from land located in _____ village.

Article 2: Place of Delivery

At the door of the company's factory at the above mentioned address and according to weighing scale bill of the company, where deliverer of tomato is considered as the seller or her representative.

Article 3

The delivered tomato should be in a good condition and without frostbite; in case of smashed, rusty, pestilent, half-colored, burnt-head product, or IN case of stem, leaf and dross, the Quality Control Unit would determine the loss rate and THE COMPANY has the right to return the cargo which has above 10 percent of loss.

Article 4: Price

The price of tomato described in Art. 2 and 3 will be fixed at the door of factory and minimum guaranteed price for each kilogram of pure tomato is _____.

Article 5

With the supervision of the agriculture unit, THE COMPANY will provide the seller with plastic baskets for transporting tomato to the extent possible to the company; based on trusteeship at the company's warehouse.

Article 6

THE COMPANY will pay the product price to the farmer, after reducing possible debts of the farmer, on a 25 percent basis every 15 days.

Article 7

The seller undertakes to return the product baskets to company's warehouse in a good condition and preparing final bill of tomato price is subject to the complete delivery of baskets. Broken baskets are considered as loss.

Article 8

The seller, if preferred, can use company's provided seeds. In case of extra seedling available, the company will give seedling to those farmers that have received seeds previously.

Article 9

During cultivation and before harvest period, the company's agriculture experts are ready to give consultation and guidance and farmers can contact them by phone at _____

Article 10

All announcements issued by the factory are affixed at the scale and at the factory's security premises. These are considered as written proclamations to the seller and their implementation is mandatory; the seller is committed to implement the transport and delivery programme of the factory.

Article 11

At the time of entering into the contract, the seller shall give a cheque to the company as good will guarantee for implementation and if, for any reason, the seller deviates to undertake the commitments of this contract, the company has the right to withdraw all its demands from this cheque.

Article 12

The seller authorizes the company to insure the tomato product by paying the amount of

During all stages of this contract, the company has the expert evaluation right and the seller has no right to complain.

Article 14: Duration of the Contract

From the time the contract comes into force until the final settlement of accounts.

This contract is prepared in 15 articles and two copies, each of which has the same commandments.
