<b>Objective:</b>	To improve human security and living standards as well as provide durable solutions for reintegration and resettlement of IDPs and returnees in Somalia, with a particular focus on IDPs currently in Bossaso
<b>Project partners:</b>	Danish Refugee Council
<b>Beneficiaries reached:</b>	2 750 vulnerable households.
<b>Activities implemented:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Construction of 200 toilet facilities in 12 IDP settlement camps.</li><li>▪ Training for 250 IDPs in vocational skills to promote income-generating activities.</li><li>▪ Training for 249 IDPs in microenterprise business skills</li><li>▪ Provision of grant materials for small-scale, start-up businesses.</li></ul>
<b>Impact</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Safe access and better health and living conditions in 12 IDP settlements, serving a total of 2 500 IDPs.</li><li>▪ Reduced cases of violence against women and girls with the establishment of toilet facilities in close proximity to shelters.</li><li>▪ Reduced vulnerability at the household level through the provision of trade and business skills training, thus improving opportunities for self employment.</li></ul>
