Introduction to the Progressive Control Pathway

Self directed e-learning course

This course introduces the Progressive Control Pathway for FMD Control (PCP). It has six modules which aim to answer common questions related to the PCP, from why is FMD control challenging, to what activities are involved in the PCP, how is a country's PCP stage assessed or what is my role in FMD control? The course is suitable for all of those with an interest in FMD control in countries that are not free of the disease, from decision makers to field veterinarians.
