

ONLINE FMD EMERGENCY PREPARATION COURSE

EuFMD's online FMD Emergency Preparation Course provides an interactive training with self-test exercises, photographs, videos and the unique opportunity to discuss all aspects of FMD control with experts and other colleagues.



Who is the course suitable for?

The course is suitable for all veterinarians who may be involved in early detection of FMD, its diagnosis, investigation or control in the event of an outbreak.

What does the course involve?

The course is studied entirely online, and will take approximately 10 hours to complete:

The course opens and closes with a live interactive webinar.

Through four interactive online modules, trainees will learn about: FMD aetiology and pathogenesis, diagnosis, epidemiology and biosecurity.

During the course, EuFMD expert trainers are available through a discussion forum to answer questions from the trainees, and to lead interactive discussions.

During and at the end of the course, assessment questionnaires allow trainees to test themselves.

Courses can be translated and tailored to a country's specific requirements. Currently available in English, Spanish, French, Russian, Italian, Estonian, Serbian, Croatian....
