


Monitoring progress of the PCP

EU FMD-three strategic goals:

- 1. To Improve readiness for FMD crisis management by Members;
- 2. To Reduce risk to Members from the FMD situation in the European neighbourhood (progressive control in neighbouring regions);
- 3. To Promote the global strategy of progressive control of FMD;
 - Progress report


Result chains relate outputs to impacts,
ideally formulating immediate,
intermediate and final outcomes

Final outcomes

- Participating country:
 - No economic losses due to FMD
- EU:
 - Reduced risk of introduction of FMD within EU



How to monitor progress

- Process → results of actions
- Results should lead to:
- Outcomes
- Example of the jackal

Stages and what to monitor

- Stage 1, 2 and beginning of 3:
 - Process → results of actions
- End of stage 3, 4 and 5:
 - Outcomes at the end of the stages:
 - Stage 3: OIE endorsement of program
 - Stage 4: OIE recognition free with vaccination
 - Stage 5: OIE recognition free without vaccination

What to monitor in stage 1

- Examples
 - Self assessment
 - Action plan (incl. external review)
 - -> SMART gives you measurable results
 - Allocated budget
 - Established contact to ref lab

Stage 2

- Stage 1 +
- E.g Initial data in target population (strategic plan)
 - Livestock data
 - Monitoring data: prevalence clinical disease
 - Serology etc
 - Process data:
 - Vaccination data
 - % objectives annual plan achieved
 - Control approved, assured lab capacity

Stage 3

- PVS mission + gap analysis
- Livestock statistics
- Surveillance and response to suspected cases
- Quality assurance of lab and vaccine uses
- → OIE endorsement of programme

Stage 4 and 5

- Outcomes measures endorsed by OIE recognition
