Overview:

Under the patronage of Cabo Verde and in collaboration with Italy and FAO, WASAG organizes the first International Forum on Water Scarcity in Agriculture. The forum will take place in Praia, Cabo Verde from 19 to 22 March 2019. The last day of the forum will coincide with the celebrations of the World Water Day 2019, with the theme “Leaving no one behind”, during which the World Water Development Report (WWDR) will be presented.

How to submit a contribution or side event?

1. Interested individuals and organizations can submit technical contributions (papers or posters) to WASAG-registration@fao.org.
2. Organizations or group of organizations can also submit proposals for a side event.
3. The due date for all the submissions is **10 February 2019**.
4. Submissions from all partners and stakeholders of WASAG, regional organizations, including the private sector from different regions of the world with a keen interest in water scarcity in agriculture are encouraged.
5. The technical contributions (including for side events) should encompass one or more of the following themes:
 - **Water and Migration:** with the specific objective of understanding links between water insecurities and migration pressures in rural areas, reinforcing social cohesion and identifying interventions that can help restore, protect and/or develop productive natural capital assets through improving water security in rural areas.
 - **Drought Preparedness:** with focus on technical and policy options aimed at contributing to the restoration and/or protection of productive natural capital affected by droughts.
 - **Water and Nutrition:** with focus on creating awareness, capacity and evidence on the linkage between water and nutrition. A key component of this topic will be policy dialogues between Agriculture and Water Ministries and those in charge of Nutrition.
 - **Sustainable Agriculture Water Use – including efficient irrigation:** with the aim to increase awareness and action by agriculture and related ministries for more sustainable agricultural water use to address water scarcity for enhanced food security and nutrition.
 - **Saline Agriculture:** with focus on supporting sustainable food production in increasingly saline environments while contributing to the restoration and/or protection of productive natural capital affected by salinity and water scarcity.
 - **Financing Mechanisms for sustainable management of water resources:** with focus on identify financing mechanisms to deal with the challenges related the management of water resources in the context of water scarcity with specific reference to migration, drought preparedness, nutrition, sustainable water management and saline agriculture.
