Launch the new FAO/UN Environment Interagency Umbrella and call for new partners and donors to support the 10YFP Sustainable Food Systems (SFS) Programme, in a joint effort to achieve sustainable food consumption and production.

Background

The UN 10 Year Framework of Programmes on Sustainable Consumption and Production Patterns (10YFP) was adopted at the Rio+20 Conference in 2012 and is inscribed in the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG 12 "Ensure sustainable consumption and production patterns").

It includes the multi-stakeholder Sustainable Food Systems (10YFP SFS) Programme, which is an action-oriented multi-stakeholder platform within the framework of the UN, established as an outcome of the 2012-2016 FAO/UN Environment joint collaboration.
