Food loss reduction goals

1. African Union: To halve the current levels of Post-Harvest Losses, by the year 2025 (June 2014)
2. UNGS: Halve per capita global food waste at the retail and consumer levels and reduce food losses along production and supply chains, including post-harvest losses by 2030 (September 2015)

AUC Level Activities

1. Develop an M&E framework for monitoring and reporting on PHL Malabo Road map
2. Mapping of existing PHL initiatives on the continent
3. Develop PH guidelines for National Agriculture Investment Plan (NAIP)
4. Develop a continental PHL strategy including a mechanism to coordinate PHL initiatives on the continent
5. Support countries to mainstream sustainable PHL strategies into their NAIPs.
6. Provide PHL technical support and training to target countries based on their work plans.

AUC Level Activities cont

1. Facilitate development of PHM curricula for integration into (Agricultural Technical Vocational. Education and Training) ATVET institutions
2. Contribute to the APHLIS (African Post-Harvest Losses Information System) portal and raise awareness of the portal
3. Contribute to the Global Food Loss awareness campaign
4. Convene meetings key partners to align their objectives with Malabo goal, SAVE FOOD/Yieldwise goals
5. A regional forum to share study findings, project outputs and lesson learnt

Country Level Activities

1. Support Governments in implementing the Malabo Road map
 1. Constitute PH Technical Working Group
 2. Develop the PHL 2025 strategy
 3. Develop indicators for the priority crops
 4. Monitor progress to 2025
2. Train Agricultural Staff on FAO food loss assessment & PM
3. Conduct loss assessment studies for one food commodity/crop (to be advised by Government) to

Country Level Activities cont.

1. Prepare and validate Food loss reduction policy briefs
2. Develop training materials on food loss assessment
3. Incorporate PHM training into agricultural tertiary curriculum
4. National workshop on AU-FAO project & Malabo road map

Potential AfDB investment areas

1. Implementation of the continental PHL strategy (components.)
2. Implementation of National PHL strategy.
3. Capacity building on PH management.
4. Support AUC to expand countries on current activities
