

BACKGROUND

Rural households, particularly small scale farmers, in the world face complex challenges such as environmental crises, food insecurity, rural livelihood insecurity, hunger and poverty. The United Nations at its 66th session of the General Assembly has declared the year 2014 as the International Year of Family Farming (IYFF) to invite the collaboration of different international and national institutions as well as farmers' organizations and non-governmental organizations to raise the profile of family farming and smallholder farming. This requires a wide range of discussion and collaborations at the national, regional and global levels to cope with these challenges. Among different strategies to support family farmers, agricultural and extension education and rural advisory services have tried to facilitate and network innovations for and among these farmers as well as to build their social capacities in order to enhance their livelihoods, increase food security and conserve natural resources. The majority of farmers in the developing world produce in small scale family farms either individually, through partnership or collectively. They are much more vulnerable to the mentioned challenges above than any other types of farming and they need the much more support of agricultural extension and rural advisory services. The theme of this conference has been defined to be "Facilitating Information and **Innovations for Empowering Family Farmers**".

SUBMISSION OF CONTRIBUTIONS

This international conference can provide an opportunity for the participants to share their knowledge and experiences regarding rural development and extension approaches to support family farmers in order to manage their challenges. Researchers, students, farmers' advisors/ extension agents and other practitioners are invited to submit their proposals relating to the topics of the conference theme and present their abstracts and papers based on their case studies and theoretical, philosophical, methodological or application focused studies. Contributions are invited from all geographical areas and field work is not limited to Asia and pacific Islands.
