This event is to show case what Papua New Guinea has done in addressing the issue of forest monitoring by field verification (ground truthing) and using remote sensing to assess the forest cover and land use information which is transparent and credible. Currently the work is undertaken by the PNG Forest Authority and other implementing agency is the Climate Change Development Authority. To determine PNG's forest cover and land use intensity, the Forest Basemap was developed and national forest and land use assessment was conducted with the technical support provided by our donor partners. As part of the REDD+ readiness, a National Forest Monitoring System for REDD+ is developed which includes a web-portal to disseminate land use, REDD+ process and safeguard information. The launching of this web portal will be a milestone for Papua New Guinea.
