AMAN encourages recognition and legal protection for indigenous peoples' at the local, national and international.

(1) The Constitutional Court Ruling No 35 on Customary Forests,

(2) Draft Indigenous Peoples Act,

(3) Inclusion of Indigenous Maps in to the One Map Initiative and the adoption of Indigenous Maps

(4) National Inquiry concerning Violations of Indigenous Land Rights in Forest Areas conducted by the National Commission on Human Rights

(5) Vision and Mission of the President of Republic of Indonesia that includes six points towards the protection of Indigenous Peoples, and

(6) The President's plan to create a special Task Force on Indigenous Peoples.

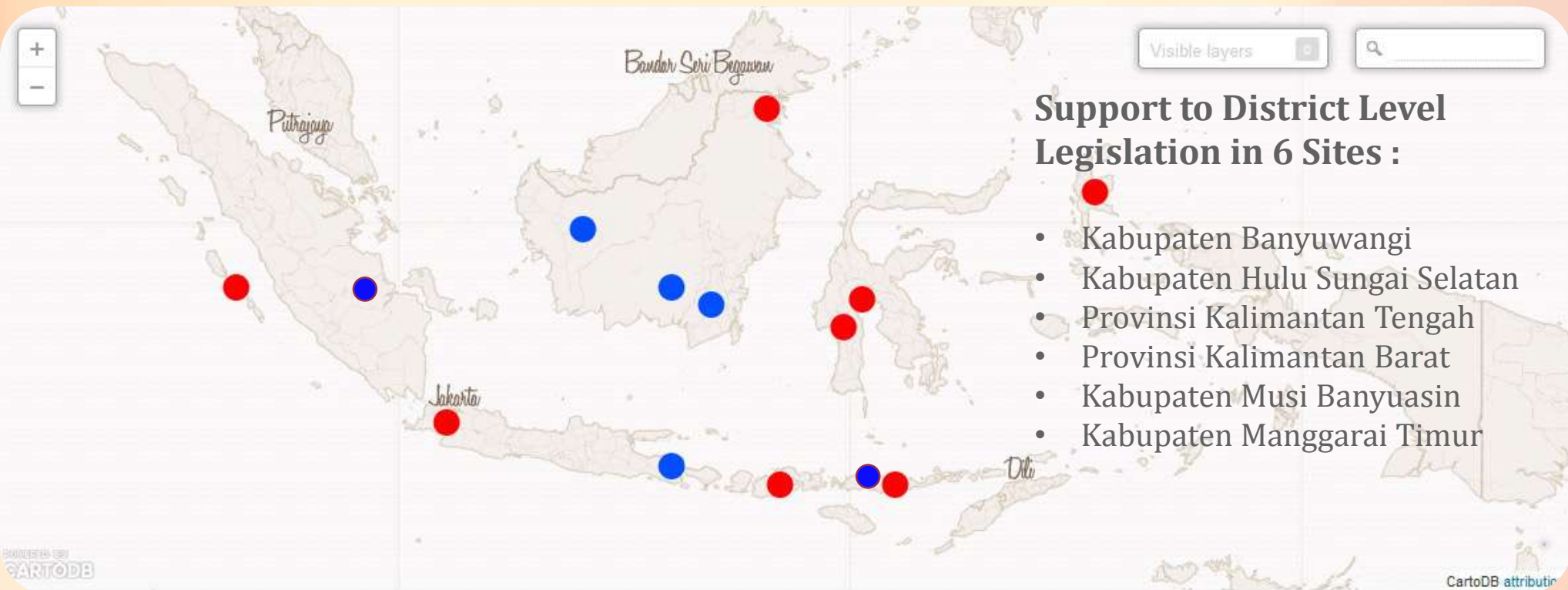
Preparatory Phase:

 - Meeting with Political Party Groups in The Parliament
 - Meeting with Minister Law and Human Rights
 - Development of materials (MK35; Briefing Papers)
