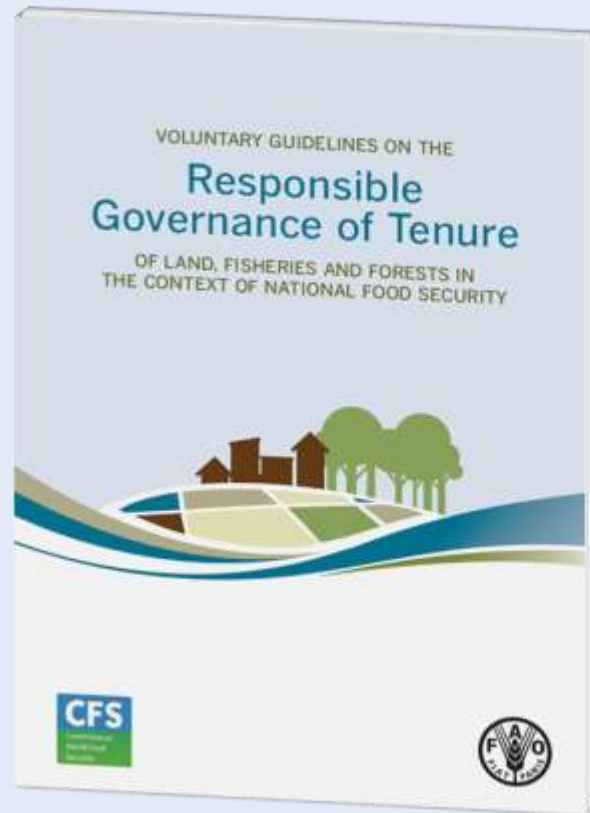

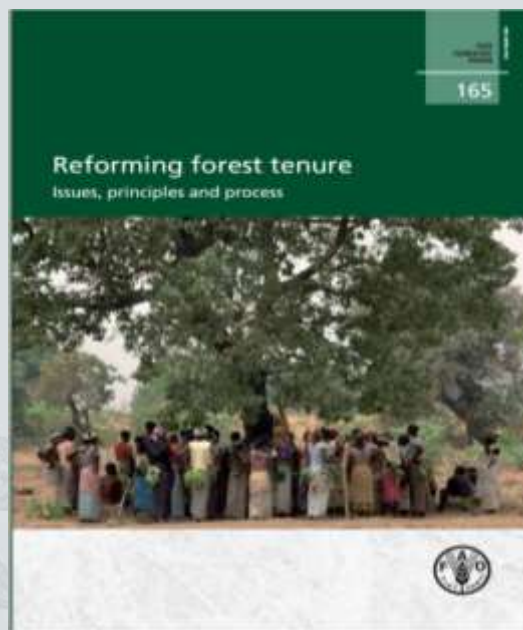
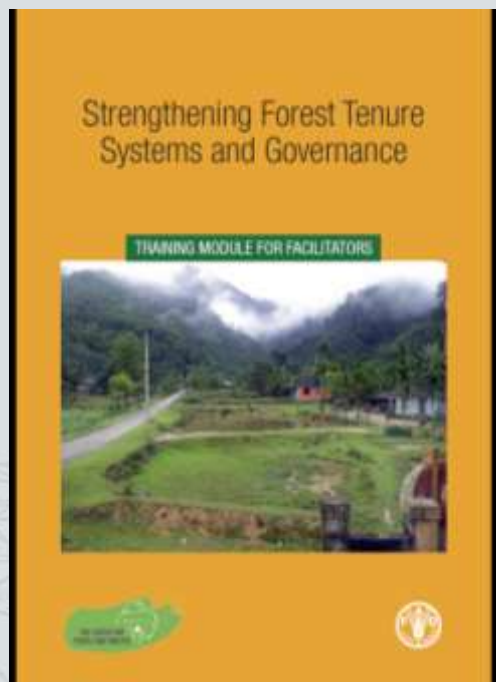

Regional TCP as pilot

- To strengthen regulatory frameworks and institutional capacity of pilot countries (Cambodia, Nepal and Viet Nam) on forest tenure.
 - forest-dependent communities in pilot countries are expected to gain more secure and stronger forest tenure rights as a key prerequisite for ensuring the contribution of forests to their livelihoods and income-generating activities.
