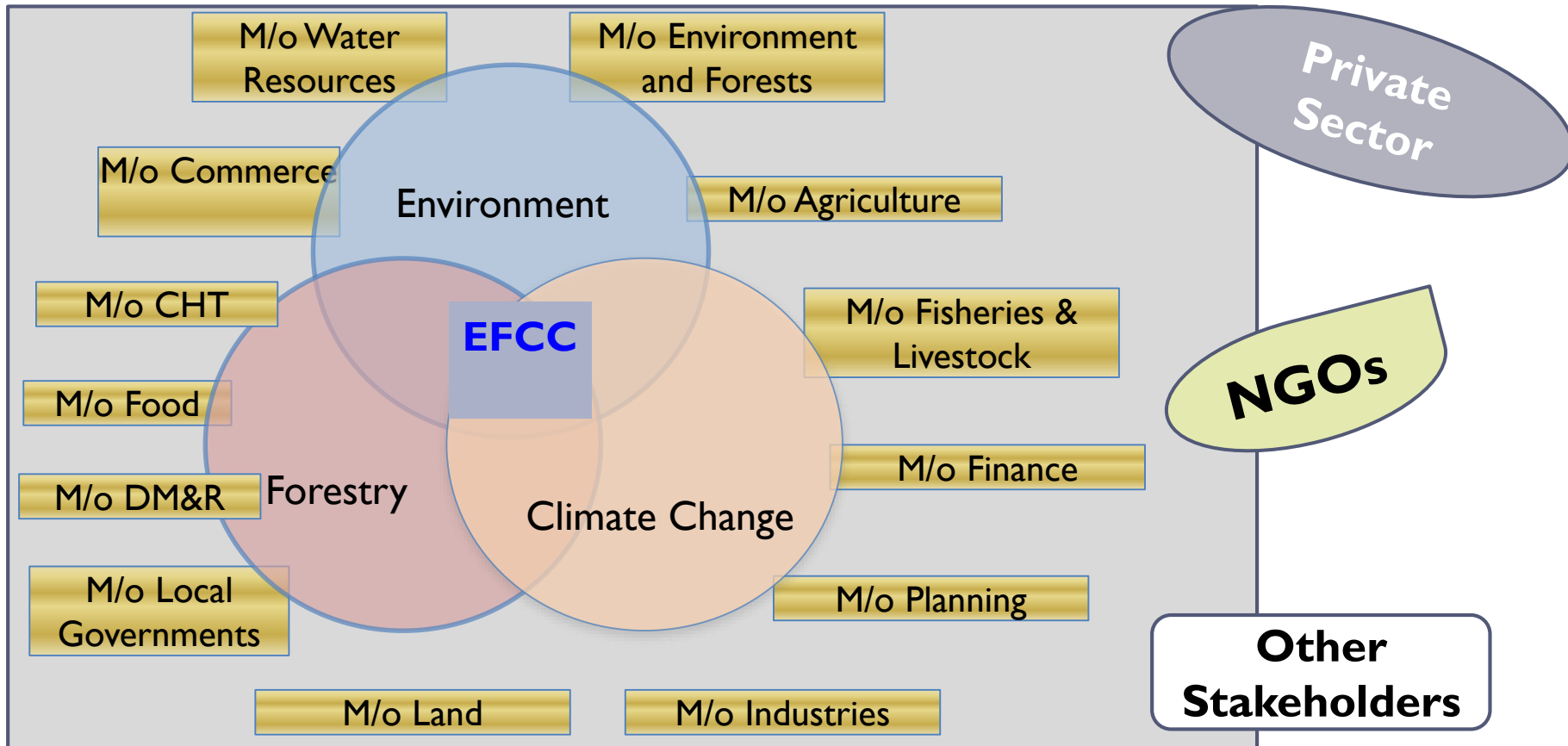

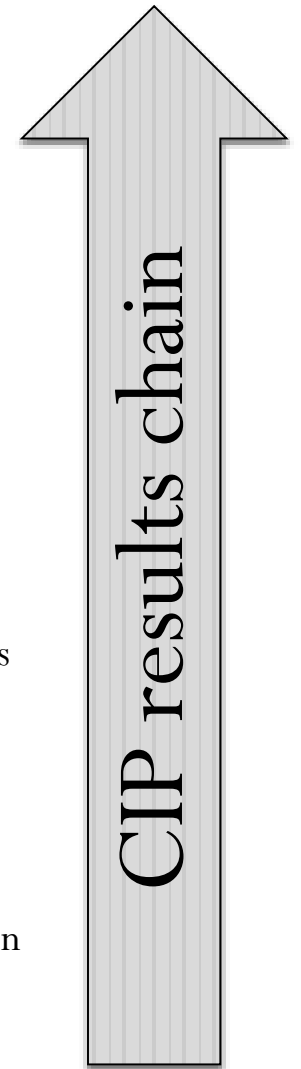

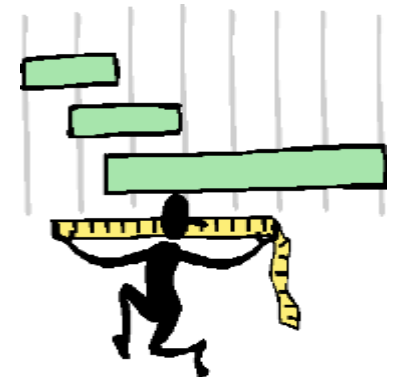

Program I.1 Sustainable Management of **Forests**

Sub-program I.1.1

Forestry value chain

Activities

- (i) Develop a national forestry inventory and satellite forest monitoring system that includes both bio-physical and socio-economic aspects
- (ii) Capacity development to implement satellite based monitoring system
- (iii) Improve linkages between monitoring data to national statistics, rural development and enforcement initiatives
- (iv) Update land records and demarcate forest areas

Indicators:

- Area of forests brought under a digital map measured in hectares
- Area of forest cover map measured in hectares

Costing: xxx million USD

Institutions: Department of Forests, Bureau of Statistics, Land Survey Directorate
