



Institutional Challenges

- EU Requirements
 - Competitive agriculture production and processing
 - Sustainable use of natural resources and diversification of the rural economy
- Globalization and Free Trade
 - Modern farmer associations
 - Management and marketing skills for high value crops
- Cross Border Collaboration and Regional Integration
 - Rural Development to reduce ethnic tensions







- Focus on limited number of priorities:
 - Competitiveness
 - Land management & environment
 - Quality of life & diversification of activities
 - Integration of LEADER bottom up approach

EU Accession Process=> Instrument for Pre-Accession

- Five components:
 - 1. Transition Assistance & Institution Building
 - 2. Regional & Cross-Border Co-operation
 - 3. Regional Development
 - 4. Human Resources Development
 - 5. Rural Development

FAO's Approach to Agriculture & Rural Development

- Income generation through agriculture & non-farm activities
 - LC as a means to improve competitiveness
 - Non-farm activities to absorb labour freed by LC
- Bottom-up approach for policy change
 - Upwards
 - => feedback to existing policies
 - => need for adaptation or new policies
 - Upwards & Downwards
 - => testing & demonstration of policies (e.g. pilot project SCG)
 - Downwards
 - => implementation & enforcement
- Regional collaboration

Land Consolidation as part of development strategies and policies ...

- Strategies on national level => based on overall national development priorities
 - Agricultural competitiveness, agri-environmental schemes
 - Support programs for specific groups (e.g. old farmers young farmers, natural handicaps)
 - New policy priorities (e.g. EU NATURA 2000, EU Water Framework Directive, HNV areas => land for protection)
 - National physical planning and national infrastructure
 - Abandoned land

... Land Consolidation as part of development strategies and policies

- Strategies on local level => based on priorities set by the stakeholders in an participatory process
 - Improve competitiveness of agriculture
 - Implement spatial planning
 - Implement local development strategies
 - Local infrastructure

EU requirements for LC and other constraints on institutional level

- Land consolidation is part of new EU rural development policy
- Land reform, privatization completed
- Cadastre and property registration in place
- National strategies for regional or rural development (e.g. SAPARD plan, Rural Development Programme, etc.)

EU support for land consolidation

- Phare
- TACIS
- CARDS
- Twinning
 - Indirect through capacity building measures and pilot projects



EU support for land consolidation

- SAPARD => one of 15 eligible measures
- IPARD => not mentioned directly under the 9 eligible measures, but IPARD regulations not yet finalized
- IPA component 1: Transition Assistance & Institution Building
- Member countries (EAGGF -> EAFRD)
- All countries; INTERREG III
