

#### Farland

The <u>aim</u> is to link public or semi-public organisations in Europe that are active in formulation and implementation of integrated land development policies in order to exchange, to develop and to stimulate properly and timely policy responses to (changing) needs of society in rural and peri-urban areas.





The <u>scope</u> is land development, meaning the broad range of public and public/private interventions to adjust the use and the ownership structure of land to the current economic, environmental and social reality. Interventions take place in 'people oriented' approaches that are carefully planned and implemented. Land development is integrated in its nature serving different objectives at local, regional and national level.

Land development is a dynamic implementation oriented approach used in specific areas with specific problems. It tries to solve problems related to land use and land ownership or to prevent future problems. Although related to spatial (physical) planning it is not a restrictive regulatory framework but a development oriented 'project-like' approach.

Land development should be embedded well in broader rural development approaches.
