Reformed in 2009 to include a wide range of stakeholders in the food security and nutrition policy setting process




CFS and its Role in Advancing Nutrition


Second International Conference on Nutrition (2014), Rome Declaration: "We recognize that (...) the UN system, including the Committee on World Food Security, and international and regional financial institutions should work more effectively together in order to support national and regional efforts, as appropriate, and enhance international cooperation and development assistance to accelerate progress in addressing malnutrition"




CFS and its Role in Advancing Nutrition

UNGA Resolution 70/2594 (2016): endorsed the ICN2 outcomes and proclaimed 2016 to 2025 the United Nations Decade of Action on and called "upon FAO and WHO to lead the implementation of the UN Decade of Action on Nutrition, in collaboration with WFP, IFAD and UNICEF, and to identify and develop a work programme (...) using coordination mechanisms such as UN SCN and multi-stakeholder platforms such as CFS (...) "
