FAO Calls for experts interested in participating in an International Study Tour in Iran on Rehabilitation of Forest and Degraded Land in Iran

The Representation of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) in the Islamic Republic of Iran in collaboration with the Forest, Range & Watershed Management Organization (FRWO) of the country invites global experts in the field of natural resources and environment management in arid and semi-arid lands, rangeland management, watershed management, forestry, desertification and rural development, to participate in an international study tour scheduled for 1-11 May 2017, covering cities of Kashan, Isfahan, Yazd, Birjand, Kerman and Tehran.

The study tour will be conducted under the framework of the “Rehabilitation of Forest Landscapes and Degraded Land with Particular Attention to Saline Soils and Areas Prone to Wind Erosion (RFLDL)” project , co-funded by Global Environment Facility (GEF) and implemented in various arid and semi-arid areas of Iran, and is aimed at 1) sharing achievements and lessons learned on Sustainable Land and Forest Management (SLFM) practices in Iran and 2) to benefit from participants’ expert assessment and advice.

The RFLDL project will bear full cost of in-country travel and accommodation. Candidates will be required to purchase their international flight tickets.
